Size 26" x 26"

Supplies

BSS

Rotary cutter and mat

Ruler, 6" x12"

Square ruler, approximately 9 or 12"

Straight pins

Thread to match the greens (or off-white)

Sewing machine with full bobbin

Materials

20 different green squares, cut 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

One 9" square of green for tree

One 4" square of green for grass

One 1 1/4" x 6" brown for tree trunk

One 9" square of blue for sky near the trunk

Two 9 1/2" squares of blue for sky setting triangles

Four 1 1/4" x 20 strips for inner border (we used purple)

Three strips 4 1/2" x width of green print fabric for outer borders

1/4 yard green print for binding

One yard backing

27" x 27" batting
