## Fabrics:

- -- 16-20 coordinating fat quarters or 8-10 half-yard cuts. Consider a feature fabric for block centers.
- -- 1/2 yard binding
- -- 1/2 yard fusible webbing for birdhouse applique
- -- Thread to match for applique elements (or wait until you get home to stitch)
- -- All rotary cutting tools, mats, scissors, thread, pins.
- -- Add a Quarter ruler (6" or 12")

While the Cobblestone and Birdhouse blocks can be patterned, the assembly is somewhat improvisational and will be determined by what fabrics remain after making your blocks! It's good to bring a little more fabric, if possible. Birdhouse blocks work best pieced with small prints (and neutral background prints). My quilt has 20 Cobblestone Blocks and 3 Birdhouse blocks; yours may differ - it's your quilt!

Quilt Size: 54" x 58" (yours may differ)
Cobblestone Blocks: 10" x 10"
Home Tweet Home Birdhouse: 7-1/2" x 10"
Optional extra birdhouses are all 10"
finished height but various widths

Select fabrics with GOOD CONTRAST.

These are PAPER PIECED. You must have an Add a Quarter ruler
